Summary of Key Achievements

- National Adolescent Health TWG operationalized; AYP National Performance Tracking Tool developed
- AYP-specific TWGs established at county level and activated to increase advocacy, community education and demand creation for SRH services
- Identification of safe spaces for AYPs to access SRH and HIV information
- Implementation of peer to peer activities and training of AYPs on facilitating online discussions
- Finalization, launch and dissemination of Community handbook on age-appropriate SRH information and life skills for adolescents, parents and community leaders
- AYPs and their parents involved in development of Adolescent Training handbook
- Health Sector response action plan developed on ending teenage pregnancy
- Youth friendly services integrated in routine health services and reporting in KHIS
- Development Partners, CSOs, private sector support:
- Policy and guidelines revision/development and dissemination through county consultative forums
 - AYP communication design packages disseminated in 13 counties
 - SGBV policy framework developed for HomaBay county
 - GBV, SRH, social and behaviour change strategies incorporating AYP developed
 - Development and operationalization of LifeYangu.com – online platform
- Capacity building and technical support to MoH (transformation of social halls into youth empowerment centres, Health Care Providers trained in youth-friendly service provision, provision of AYSRH guidelines and job aids, training in Values Clarification and Attitude Transformation, 106 HCPs trained on LARC and postpartum FP and counselling skills).
 - Kilifi County equipped with 46 IUCD insertion sets, 26 IUCD removal sets, 40 autoclave machines, 10 gynaecological lamps, 9 Vasectomy sets, 30 Tubal ligation kits, 50 Tiaht charts, 20 cue cards, and 50 FP demonstration bags
- Evidence based advocacy for decision making efforts
