### Summary of Key GoK Achievements

- Conducted physical facilities capacity assessment in 356 TVETs and quality assurance audits in 415 TVETs
- Construction of TTIs and TVCs at Constituency level: 126 new TVETs completed and operationalized out of a target of 169
- 265 departments in 1,929 operational institutions equipped with state of the art equipment 4 of which are Special Technical Training institutions
- TVETs rebranding and repositioning campaigns conducted to improve enrolment
- 52 curricula for highly demanded skills developed
- 30 learning guides covering 133 courses developed under CBET Curriculum
- Initiation of career guidance, counselling and mentorship policy development
- 35 institutions capacity built on implementation of national qualifications framework
- Increase in capitation and TVET HELB loan disbursement

### Summary of Key Contributions of Development Partners, CSOs and Private Sector

- 414 trainers supported to join three technical universities to study Engineering & Technology; 530 trained in pedagogy at KTTC and 157 TVET principals trained in financial management and corporate governance
- Support to develop competency based curricula and 102 ToTs trained in digital content development
