Summary of Key GoK Achievements

- Development of CBC curriculum and support materials
- Roll out of CBC in basic education achieved up to Grade 6
- Support implementation of Competency Based Assessment Framework and exam administration
- Development of Kenya Early Years Assessment and web portal
- 50 curriculum designs for Grade 10 developed and 64 curriculum designs adapted to special needs learners
- Capacity building of 150,225 CBC implementers
- Digital Learning: 168 interactive items for Grade 5 developed; 520 electronic curriculum support materials developed with 23 adapted for special needs learners
- Grade 6 course materials evaluated
- 276,356 CBC programmes produced and broadcast on Radio, TV and Cloud (Kenya Education Cloud)
- CBC implementation in Pre-Primary Grades 1&2; Primary Grades 1-5 monitored and evaluated by KICD
- CBC national assessments: 1,377,009 grade 4 learners in 36,377 primary schools assessed; 1,272,830 grade 5 learners in 36,548 primary schools subjected to SBA (School Based Assessment)
- 5,205 CBC classrooms constructed for Junior Secondary in public secondary schools – target was 3,365
- 55,000 secondary school teachers capacity built for roll out of junior secondary school CBC; 2,450 SNE teachers trained on CBA
- Curriculum reforms for teacher education finalized and operationalized
- ICT Integration: establishment of smart classrooms 1,000 public primary schools; recruitment of 600 ICT interns; 1,901 teachers were trained on ICT integration; 476 head teachers and 315 principals sensitized on ICT integration; 2,020 computers procured for 196 secondary schools

- Support capacity building of county ECDE teaching and non-teaching staff
- Pedagogical skills enhancement training conducted for 2,590 and 8,810 mathematics and science teachers at primary and secondary schools, respectively
