### Summary of Key Achievements by State and non-State Actors

- Sensitization of community gatekeepers and opinion leaders on elimination of the Triple Threat (New HIV Infections, Adolescents Pregnancies and Sexual Gender-Based Violence) was undertaken in 14 Counties;
- Development and implementation of a coordinated framework that brings the county governments, line ministries, state agencies and communities to address the Triple Threat challenge at the county level;
- Medical staff in 13 counties were sensitized on the trainer's manual on clinical management of GBV
- Forensic management training conducted in Machakos County
- development of a population and development database to support actors in the humanitarian field to enhance their preparedness, mitigation and response to emergencies initiated
- healthcare workers in the 47 counties trained on integrated messages for community education and mobilization to continue service utilization.
- use of data for advocacy including tracking of GBV cases and RH service utilization in KHIS was enhanced to drive policy discussion and response
