FY2021/2022

Progressively increase health sector financing to 15 percent of total budget, as per the Abuja declaration, by 2030

Summary of Key Achievements

- increased health budget from Kes.111.7 billion in 2020/21 to Kes.121.1 billion in 2021/22 (to strengthen UHC especially maternal health, FP and HIV commodities)
- Counties' commitment to allocate not less than 30% of their budgets to health
- annual forecasting and quantification for FP and HIV commodities report finalized and the National Supply Chain Strategy completed.
- Government procured Approx. 87% of FP commodities through matching-fund arrangement

- Getting to 100% domestic funding for family planning commodities
- Health is wealth, improving population health makes economic sense
