Summary of Key Achievements by GoK

- 4 stakeholder advocacy forums on social protection legal frameworks
- Implementation of economic empowerment project in Makeni, Marsabit, Kisumu, Taita Taveta and Murang'a – 6,211 beneficiaries
- Operationalization of the national social protection steering committee and populated data on poor and vulnerable populations in Kisumu, Taita Taveta, Baringo, Kilifi, Kisii, Migori, Kwale, Lamu, Tharaka Nithi, Narok, Laikipia, West Pokot, Kitui and Murang'a
- Inua Jamii programme benefited 1092551 (34,536 PwSD; 294,345 OVCs; and 763,670 older persons)
- 24,992 PWDs registered to enable them access various services from state and non-state actors
- Nutrition Improvement through Cash and Health Education (NICHE) project implementation for expectant women and children below 2years benefited 7,743 in Kitui, Kilifi, West Pokot, Marsabit and Turkana
- 5,000 persons with albinism provided with sunscreen lotion
- Presidential Bursary programme offered scholarships to 22,300 OVCs
- 4,250 street persons reintegrated to the community
- Establishment of Kirinyaga Rescue Centre for abused and neglected older persons
- Improved social security coverage through NSSF: 456,502 new members registered; 39,912 new employers registered; Members' funds increased by Kes.5.22billion
- Continued advocacy for Haba Haba savings plan for informal sector workers

- Complimentary support in tracking, monitoring and reporting on ICPD25 commitments implementation
- Support commemorations events, launch and dissemination of ICPD25 reports and related documents

- 11 ICPD25 dissemination forums for youth and CSOs networks held in Bungoma, Trans Nzoia, West Pokot, Nandi, Uasin Gishu, Nakuru, Meru, Nyandarua, Laikipia, Mombasa and Kilifi supported by DSW
