Summary of Key Contributions of State, Development Partners, CSOs and Private Sector

- The Demographic Roadmap disseminated to 216 MCAs and 156 implementers
- Development and launch of YSRH online Platform (https://www.lifeyangu.com/)
 hosted by DSW Kenya
- 16 County TWGs on ending the triple threat in adolescence established in high burden counties
- sensitized 89,000 Youth on UHC and enrolled 17,400 youth into the National Hospital Insurance Fund (NHIF)
- trained 87,331 youth in various skills: 12,284 on life skills, 11,989 in core business skills while 11,962 were trained in specific skills training; trained 17,047 youth in para military training; 34,049 trained in technical and vocational skills
- placed 11,105 youth on internship
- provided 71,715 workers with industrial training to upgrade their skills
- certified 153,291 persons through government trade testing
- placed 30,057 students on industrial attachment
- 89,572 job seekers were placed in employment locally and abroad
- provided pre-departure training to 92,875 outbound Kenya migrant workers
- regulated 435 Private Employment Agencies to ensure safe and orderly recruitment of Kenyan migrant workers
- Youth Enterprise Development Fund disbursed Ksh. 403.6 million reaching 31,112 youth beneficiaries and creating and upscaling 3,746 sustainable business enterprises
- capacity building of youth on leadership was undertaken for 22,100 youth
- engaged 7,600 youth in volunteerism and community service and
- Youth Civic Engagement Strategy developed
- 53,870 youth sensitized on Access to Government Procurement Opportunities
